

EASTER WALK IN THE PARK

Enjoy the ducks and aquatic life along Marsh and Foster Islands, and the beauties of Spring in the UW Washington Park Arboretum on our walk on Saturday, April 3. The free, noncompetitive walk will start at UW Parking Lot E-5, near the UW Center for Urban Horticulture, and will have 5 and 10 kilometer alternative routes (3.1 and 6.2 miles). Walkers will start anytime between 9 AM and 1 PM, and must finish by 4 PM.

The walk will include sidewalks, and gravel and bark trails on Foster and Marsh Islands and in the Arboretum. It is not suitable for wheelchairs or small strollers. Dogs must be leashed and kept out of beaches, playgrounds and natural areas.

The walk is sponsored by the Emerald City Wanderers and is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association. Volkssport credit is available.

Directions: From I-5, exit at SR520, and then take the Montlake Blvd exit from 520. At the light, turn left on Montlake Blvd, getting in the right lane and continue about 1 mile to Mary Gates Blvd. Turn right and follow signs to E-5 parking lot. There is a \$2 fee until noon for parking.
