Halloween Walk

You're invited to enjoy the autumn colors on a country walk starting at Remlinger Farms near Carnation on Saturday and Sunday, October 30-31. Walk for fitness, friendship and fun on a non-competitive, 10-kilometer (6 mile) or 5-kilometer (3 mile) route. Wear a costume and be eligible for a prize. And, watch for goblins on the trail – they will be bearing treats! After the walk, enjoy Remlinger's Fall Harvest Festival and visit the Farm Market and Pumpkin Patch. The walk is free, but there is a charge for the Festival.

Walkers may start anytime between 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM, and must finish by 4:00 PM. Members of the American Volkssport Association can earn IVV credit for a fee.

Take Exit #22 off I-90, and follow the Preston/Fall City Road to Fall City. Cross the bridge at Fall City, turn left onto SR #203, and follow it for 5 miles to NE 32nd, the turn-off for Remlinger Farms and the parking area for the walk.
